Recommendations

Please keep in mind that water is an uncontrollable force of nature and none of the buoyancy aids can absolutely eliminate the risk of injury, they can only minimize it. Therefore do not take unnecessary risks and go kayaking, etc. alone. None of the buoyancy aids can replace a friend you can rely on for help. The Marine buoyancy aids are intended for use by swimmers only, and for situations where other help is available nearby. They are not designed as life jackets for non-swimmers or unconscious persons! This is not a life jacket: Buoyancy aids only reduce the risk of drowning they

do not guarantee rescue. For swimmers only. For use in sheltered waters with help at hand. Do not use as a cushion. Rinse with fresh water after use and hang up to dry. Always close all zippers and buckles as well as fasten the jacket snugly to your body. An opened buoyancy aid is a hindrance in the water!

Harness belt with a quick releasing buckle

All buoyancy aid intended for more difficult conditions are equipped with a quick releasing buckle. The harness belt is used to bring a swimming person to the waterside or for pulling a boat by towline. The quick

releasing buckle allows swift unfastening even when the belt carries a heavy load. The harness belt does not substitute for a climbing harness for rappelling under any circumstances! Make sure to thread the belt correctly through the buckle according to the diagram

Care and maintenance of the buoyancy aid

Do not fold the buoyancy aid or use it as a cushion or a seat! It is best to store the Buoyancy aid hanging on a hanger. Protect it from sunlight and heat or frost. Rinse the buoyancy aid with clean water after every use, and dry it in the air. Never dry it by hot air, place

it directly on a heater or iron it! Wash the by hand in soap solution for heavy soil, using a soft brush if necessary. Do not use a washing machine or dry clean. Regularly check the seams, belts, pins, buckles, , etc. Have the detected defects repaired by a professional.
